Summit proudly offers academic and themed camps for eight weeks during the summer for K–6th grade students. Summit also continues to present intensive academic camps designed to help build a strong foundation in reading/writing and/or math.

In addition to academic camps, Summit builds upon the acronym of STEAM (Science, Technology, Engineering, Arts, Math) with the addition of “R” - Reading and Writing. S.T.R.E.A.M. themed camps will be offered weekly. Although all courses/lessons taught within a week will focus on one specific area of S.T.R.E.A.M., students will be instructed by teachers in smaller groups based on their age-appropriate classroom groupings. These courses are sure to be engaging, interactive, and hands-on, **with the majority of coursework performed outdoors!**

Summit Schools has operated in-person during the 2020-21 school year while following the health and safety protocols as determined by the CDC and Linn County Public Health. Summit camps are kept small to provide an optimum learning environment.

Students who are registered for a full-day themed camp will have supervised lunch and recess between 11:30 a.m. – 12:30 p.m. Students should bring a lunch from home that does not require heating or cooling. Please note that lunch is not provided and students must be registered in a full-day themed camp to participate in the lunch and recess option.

week 3: reading/writing

June 21 – 25

do you love getting lost in your thoughts or letting your imagination run wild? Students will engage their imaginations while reading and writing poetry, journaling, playwriting, composing short stories, etc. about the world around them. Students will have the whole week to discover their inner author! **(For grades K – 6)**



week 4: engineering

June 28 – July 2

are you someone who just itches to know how things are made or how they work? Come along as we explore Rube Goldberg contraptions, LEGOS®, simple machines and more! Students will use the scientific method to design, build, test, and problem solve. We'll even put our detective skills to the test and crack some MythBusters cases! **(For grades K – 6)**

ready, set, let's be artistic! Free your inner virtuoso with a week of fine art! We will explore drawing, painting, sculpture, photography and music. Campers will get a chance to explore new mediums and find new creative ways to use their imaginations. 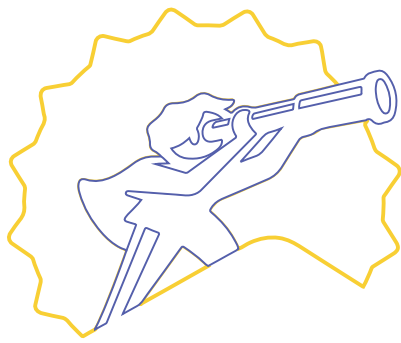

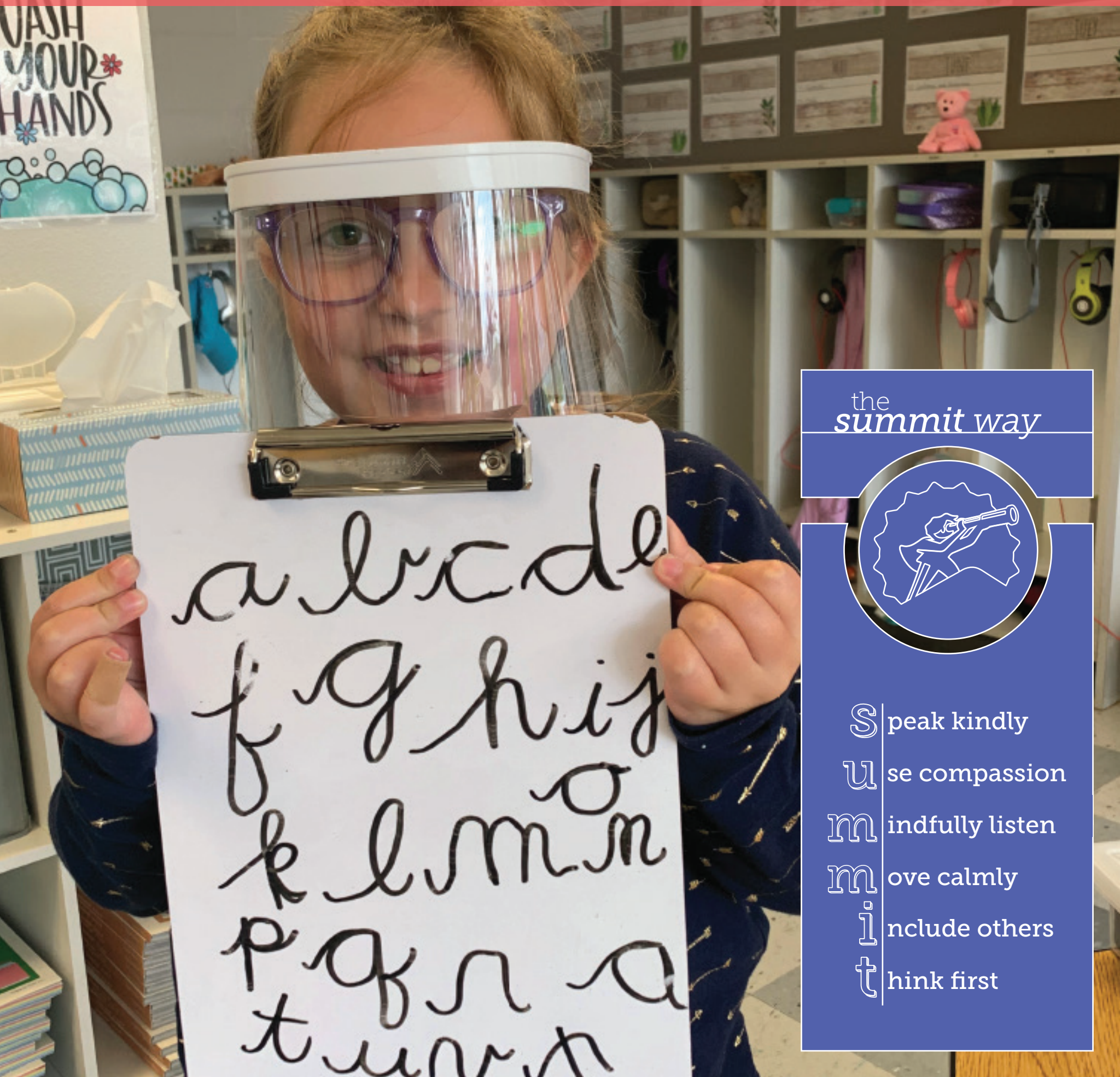
