### Information on ISASP Reports

- All students in grades 3-11 participated in Iowa Statewide Assessment of Student Progress (ISASP) Testing in April & May.
- Pearson (the testing company) has communicated that final achievement level reporting for the individual student, school, district, and state will be available in early August. This includes the Individual Student Reports that present all achievement level information for tests taken. This report will be shared with parents.
- In addition, Pearson has communicated that a Parent Portal, a secure online site hosted by Pearson, will be available in August and will offer Iowa families direct access to view their student's results outside of the school setting.
- **Results from Spring 2021 ISASP testing will be shared with families in the Fall of 2021.**
