Masking on Buses - Asking Families to Provide Masks

The CDC issued an <u>Order</u> effective February 1, 2021, requiring masks on public transportation. This mask requirement <u>DOES</u> include school buses. The lowa Department of Public Health clarified how this CDC Order impacts the masking restrictions for schools in HF 847. As stated in this <u>IDPH School Update</u>, masks <u>will be</u> required on school busses traveling to and from school and activities until further notice.

We are asking families to provide masks for their children who ride the bus. Disposable masks will be available on each bus but with the numbers of students we transport daily, we need students to bring their own masks from home whenever possible.
