College Community Will Celebrate Iowa Local Food Day on October 13

Our district has partnered with <u>Field to Family</u> to source locally grown produce for this event. Field to Family is an educational nonprofit food hub that connects students and educators to local food and farmers and works to expand access to local food for more people in the community through the purchase, aggregation, storage, marketing and delivery of fresh, safe, local food.

Students in grades K-9 will be offered locally grown apples and heirloom cherry tomatoes during lunch. We will be slicing up Bella and Silken apple varieties. The apples are being sourced from Buffalo Ridge Orchard which is located in Central City, IA. The tomatoes are being sourced from Flint Ridge in Kalona, IA.

Students in grades 10-12 will be offered locally grown apple slices, delicata squash, and kale during lunch. All three of these items are being sourced from Flint Ridge in Kalona, IA.
