# Now Hiring - Paraprofessionals

The College Community School District is currently hiring Paraprofessionals for positions throughout our district. We are looking for those with a strong work ethic, great attendance, and most importantly enjoys working with students while assisting the classroom teacher in providing instructional support and ensuring a positive learning environment for all.

Our Paraprofessional salary is \$16.32 per hour after the successful completion of a 90-day probationary period. This is a 10 month- school year position with approximately 7 hours per day = 35 hours per week.

Hours vary per building.

- Creek Intermediate and Point Middle School 7:30-3:00
- Elementary and High School 8:30-4:00

Benefits include:

- District group health insurance (district pays the cost of single coverage for the employee)
