VOLUNTEERS AND VISITORS UPDATE

Beginning January 18th, College Community parents and visitors will be allowed in our school buildings and classrooms to volunteer and attend classroom activities when requested or invited and when prior approval is granted by the teacher or principal. Current school drop-off and pick-up procedures will remain the same. Parents may still call the office to have their children picked up or dropped off during the school day without having to come into the building or they may park and pick up or drop them off in the office. At this time, we will not be allowing visitors for mealtimes.

Masking is encouraged. If the school is under a mask mandate, visitors and volunteers will be expected to comply with that mandate. The mask mandate for school transportation is still in effect. Contact your building with any questions.

TRANSPORTATION - DRIVER SHORTAGE

We continue to have a major shortage of bus drivers. Most days we have our mechanics and office staff, including our Transportation Director driving to cover routes. When this occurs we can't always communicate as timely as we would like in regards to late buses. Please know that we are doing our best to get all students to school safely.

FOOD AND NUTRITION

We continue to battle supply chain disruptions and we are experiencing many item shortages which have led to menu changes. Thank you for your patience and continued support of the meal program. As a reminder, <u>all students</u> have access to a free breakfast meal <u>and</u> lunch meal daily, Monday- Friday, when school is in session. (On 2-hour delay days, breakfast is not served.) All students are encouraged to eat school meals. All students have access to purchase la carte options such as a single carton of milk, snacks, beverages, etc. A la carte items are not included with free meals. A la carte items may be purchased with a positive meal account balance.

We are seeing an increasing demand for vegetarian/ vegan options from students and staff. CCSD Food and Nutrition will soon offer meatless options such as nuggets, meatballs, and a vegan patty as an option on our menu.
