STUDENT ISOLATION PERIOD

Students who are positive for COVID-19 will continue to be required to stay home from school for the ten-day isolation period. Guidance from public health departments requires individuals who are positive to wear masks upon ending isolation prior to ten days and continuous masking is not possible in the school setting throughout the day.

TEMPORARY MASKING CONDITIONS

Masks are strongly encouraged. In the event that $\geq 2\%$ of students are actively COVID positive at an individual school at the time of weekly data collection AND the 5-school-day average daily attendance for illness is $\geq 8\%$ (excludes quarantine), a building/site-specific temporary mask mandate will be implemented for 10 school days. The temporary mask mandate could be extended only if the temporary masking metrics are not met after that 10-day period.

HARD SURFACE ROADS

Please check your Parent Portal account which will indicate if your student is on a hard surface only route. Some bus times and bus numbers will be different for hard surface only. If you have questions please contact our office, 319-848-5204.

Our transportation department has a Hard Surface Only route plan that will be implemented when conditions on gravel roads are determined too hazardous for school buses. The purpose of this plan is to provide alternative bus stops to students who are normally picked up and/or dropped off at stops located on gravel roads. Many of our hard surface routes only have portions of the road that we have to avoid which in turn alters the bus stop times for everyone on the route. District announcements will be made when we implement this plan.

SCHOOL CANCELLATIONS - WEATHER CLOSINGS AND DELAYS
