



Spanish Verb Camp

August 17 & 18

The Humble Language Institute is offering a Spanish Verb Camp for students in the Cedar Rapids area. The 10-hour Camp will be offered on August 17th and 18th at the Ladd Library in Cedar Rapids.

This Camp is a great opportunity for students to sharpen their skills using 12 different Spanish verb tenses. The first part of the Camp is an intensive review of the verb tense meanings and the conjugations of the tenses that they have learned through Spanish 3. It will also cover the verb tenses that will be covered in Spanish 4. The second part of the Camp focuses on using the verbs tenses in conversational practice. Cultural information is woven throughout the course.

The Verb Camp is open to students that have completed Spanish 3 or above. For students entering Spanish 4, this Camp is a great way to help them review and prepare for their final years of Spanish. For students who have completed Spanish 4, this Camp provides an excellent review for a Spanish 5 or AP class. The class size is limited to 16 students.

The investment for the Humble Verb Camp is \$15.00 per hour and a \$40.00 materials fee.

The instructor will be Jason Humble. Jason was a Peace Corps volunteer from 1993 to 1995. While there, he met and married his Carmen. Jason developed and taught conversational Spanish at Kirkwood Community College from 1999 to 2016. He and Carmen have owned and operated an interpreting business in Cedar Rapids since 2005.
