## WHAT IS PERSONALIZED LEARNING?

Personalizing learning is an instructional approach that empowers students to build ownership of their learning. Educators personalize learning by targeting instruction, fostering collaboration and creativity, facilitating reflection and goalsetting, and designing flexible learning learning experiences. Personalizing learning is an active and ongoing process. It is a student-centered approach to learning that calls on educators to be responsive to the needs of their students. When students get the instruction they need, when they need it, they are more engaged, successful, and better prepared for post-high school education/training and career success.



## WHY DO WE PERSONALIZE **LEARNING?**

#### **EQUITY EQUITABLE LEARNING ENVIRONMENTS:**

- ensure safety, access, and success for every student through the use of Universal Design for Learning (UDL) and an effective Multi-Tiered System of Supports;
- honor the diverse needs of every student by incorporating multiple pathways to learn and demonstrate learning:
- use instructional materials and strategies that proactively address barriers to learning;
- develop systems that ensure equitable access to programs and services.

#### **ENGAGEMENT ENGAGED STUDENTS:**

- · connect cognitively, emotionally, socially, and behaviorally:
- demonstrate curiosity to learn and explore;
- integrate tools and strategies for asking and seeking answers to questions;
- embrace the purpose of learning through voice, choice, goal-setting, practice, and reflection.

#### **EMPOWERMENT EMPOWERED STUDENTS:**

- have opportunities to co-create learning experiences with their teachers and/or peers.

# **HOW** DO WE PERSONALIZE

Nurturing learning environments create the conditions to personalize learning. Building caring and supportive relationships with students that honor their identities and backgrounds strengthens their sense of belonging in our learning spaces. Our personalized learning system includes a Multi-Tiered System of Supports that ensures all students experience a guaranteed and viable curriculum along with support to meet their individual needs. Educators design for student variability using the Universal Design for Learning (UDL) framework. Professional learning communities engage in cycles of inquiry while blending traditional, researchbased pedagogy and innovative practice to develop student agency. Educators use the Core Four Elements of Personalized Learning from Education Elements to infuse personalized learning into our classrooms and schools.

STUDENT REFLECTION AND GOAL SETTING: Students set, track and reflect on their own learning goals and make

connections between the choices they make in class and their goal.

TARGETED INSTRUCTION: Students can articulate what instruction they are receiving and why, and have some choice over the instruction they receive.

#### **COLLABORATION & CREATIVITY:**

Students work in groups to generate novel ideas and solutions to complex problems.

FLEXIBLE PATH & PACE: Students are able to choose their path and pace as they work through material.
