The 6th Street SW, south of 76th Avenue project included pavement reconstruction and access to new development via a roundabout, new sidewalk and trail, additional turn lanes, utility upgrades, and new trees and plantings.

## **Breakfast & Lunch**

Legislators did not extend free meals for all children for the 2022-23 school year. We will return to charging for meals as we did before the pandemic.

#### Meal Prices:

- Breakfast for Grades K-12: \$1.95. Adult \$2.30
- Lunch for Grades: K-4 \$2.95, 5-6 \$3.05, 7-12 \$3.20, Adult \$4.15
- Milk: \$0.50 (1 carton of milk is included with a meal.)
- Students approved for reduced price meals: \$0.30 for breakfast, \$0.40 for lunch.
   Snacks, beverages (including milk), and additional meal items are available for purchase at all grade levels. If a student would like to purchase these items, their meal account must have enough funds to cover the cost. Creek limits these purchases to 2 items. Spending limits may be set for all students in the Total Access Parent Portal.

If you feel that your household may qualify for free or reduced price meal benefits, please complete the online application <a href="mailto:here">here</a>. Printable forms or paper forms are also available. A new application for your household needs to be completed each year. (One application per household.) Free and reduced status is confidential and protected by federal law. This information can only be shared with your consent. Please do not hesitate to apply.
