The College Community School District and the YMCA of Cedar Rapids Metropolitan Area to Perform Extensive Community Needs Assessment for Recreation/Wellness Center on the College Community Campus

Prairie Families:

Providing our growing student population with an onsite pool/aquatics center has been a point of discussion for several decades. Now that we are nearing completion of College Community School District's (CCSD) 10-year master plan to ensure updated and adequate spaces to accommodate a growing student population, we are now able to turn our attention to amenities and programming to further enhance the student/family experience CCSD.

In envisioning an aquatics center, the District Facilities Committee would like to consider a facility to provide a full service, multi-generational recreation and wellness center for the entire College Community Schools Community. In this visioning process, we have developed a partnership with the YMCA of the Cedar Rapids Metropolitan Area to operate this facility if approved by residents.

CCSD and the YMCA are conducting a full program and community Needs Assessment throughout the College Community School District and surrounding service area.

The Cedar Rapids YMCA and College Community School District have engaged Triangle2 Solutions to perform a full program and community needs assessment throughout the College Community School District and surrounding areas.

The study will specifically assess the feasibility of a community center located on the school campus across from Prairie Crest Elementary. This potential facility would serve students, as well as all residents of the College Community School District and the surrounding areas.

A wide range of facilities, programs and services will be tested, including an indoor track, aquatics facilities, pickleball courts and many other program areas.

Several hundred homes in the CCSD area will be <u>called</u> or <u>emailed</u> will be contacted. Community participation and feedback through the survey is welcome and encouraged. Residents will be randomly selected to participate in a phone survey, and an online survey will be available to ensure all who are interested get to give their feedback.
