Developmental Academy

For Boys & Girls, Age 6-7

Basic Developmental Program

Schedule For the Fall 2023 season, the program will start on Sunday, September 10 and run through Sunday October 22. There will be six (6) Sundays that we play on and we have two Sundays as make-up dates should there be a reason to postpone a day (i.e. weather issues). We will play a three week block in September (September 10, 17, and 24) and a three week block in October (October 8, 15, and 22). We will use October 1 and October 29 as make-up dates, with the first date being the make-up for the September dates and the second for the October dates. If we do not have any postponements then those dates will be off weekends. Each Sunday will consist of two parts: a 30 minute skills session followed by a game.

Teams Teams will not be pre-determined before the season. Each Sunday the PSC Iowa coaching staff will divide the teams, after the skills session, for the games. This is done so that each player gets to play games with most, if not all, the other players in their age group. This helps the players with their social development and also limits any "competitive imbalance" to a single game instead of the entire season.

Uniform Each player will receive two PSC Iowa Developmental shirts, one white and one black, as part of their registration fee. This shirt will serve as their uniforms for each Sunday. Each player will be required to provide their own shorts, socks, shin guards, and soccer shoes. It is requested, but not required, that players wear black shorts and black soccer socks.

Ball Each player is required to provide their own soccer ball. This is necessary for the skills portion of each Sunday. Each age has a specific size ball that the players will need to bring. The following table shows what size soccer ball is required, by group:

- Pre-Kindergarten/Kindergarten (ages 4-5) - Size 3
- 1st Grade/2nd Grade (ages 6-7) - Size 3
- 2nd Grade/3rd Grade (ages 8-9) - Size 4

Developmental Academy

Training Developmental Academy teams will train from mid-August to the end of October in the fall and mid-March (after spring break) through the first week in June for the spring season. The training sessions will be conducted at the Prairie and Kirkwood soccer fields by PSC Iowa coaching staff. Each team will train at least one (1) day a week, for 60-75 minutes per session, with their designated PSC Iowa staff coach.

PSC Iowa follows a specifically designed, age-specific, curriculum that will help the players develop their soccer skills and instill a love for the game. We will also offer playing and training options in January and February.

Coaching Staff All training is planned and overseen by PSC Iowa's Academy Director, Michael Robertson. He has over 30 years of coaching experience, including 17 years coaching college, 23 years of high school coaching, and over 12 years coaching club soccer. He holds a US Soccer National D License and is currently earning a US Soccer National C License.

The main assistant coach to the Academy Director is Steven Robertson. Steve has an impressive background coaching soccer, including over 15 years coaching college, 25 years coaching high school, over 12 years coaching club soccer, and 5 years experience as a staff coach in the Iowa ODP program. He also holds a US Soccer National D License and is currently completing the course to get his National C License.

All other staff coaches will complete their applicable Grass Roots license before coaching for PSC Iowa.

Leagues The Developmental Academy players will participate in the PSC Iowa Developmental League (PSC-DL). The PSC -DL is played on six (6) Sundays, and the dates for the Fall 2023 season are: September 10, September 17, September 23, October 8, October 15, and October 22. The make-up dates will be September 30 for the September days, and October 29 for the weekends in October.

Developmental Academy Friendlies In addition to league play, the PSC Iowa Developmental Academy also participates in inter-club friendlies with other local soccer clubs in the Cedar Rapids area. The friendlies are a festival-style event where other U7/U8 teams from other clubs get together and play matches against each other. This allows for our Developmental Academy to get competition against other teams that have received like training and allows for much more competitive games. For the friendlies, we will play 4-a-side games with no goalkeepers. The Developmental Academy will participate in at least one of these events per season.

Ball Each player is required to provide their own soccer ball that they will need at every training session and on the Sunday league games. For this age, the players will need a size 3 soccer ball.
