#### **Preferred Names and Pronouns**

There are options available to families regarding the school's role in recognizing and valuing a student's preferred identity. Effective for the 2023-2024 school year and in accordance with Senate File 496, a student's legal guardian must provide written permission to allow school staff to implement an accommodation related to a student's gender identity that is different from their gender assigned at birth.
