Meal Account Balance

Parents, please check your family meal account balance and make a payment if your balance has fallen below \$0.00. To check your balance, login to the <u>Total Access Family Portal</u>. To make payments online, login to <u>In Touch</u>. Cash and check payments can be sent with your child and dropped off in the office or store. All balances carryover to the next school year. If you are leaving the district and have a positive account balance, you have the following options:

- Request a refund in writing to the Building Clerk or Food and Nutrition Dept. (Include the address that you want the refund mailed to.)
- Donate the remaining balance to unpaid student meal accounts
- Transfer the funds to a specific student or staff member in the district
