Breakfast

Breakfast is served in the cafeteria daily unless school is delayed. Breakfast is available to all students even if they arrive late. Breakfast costs \$2.05 for students in grades K-12. Reduced price breakfast is \$0.30. Students are offered:

- A choice of cereal or breakfast entree
- Whole Grain Toast
- Fruit
- 100% Juice Cup
- 8 oz. Carton of Plain or Chocolate Milk

To build a student breakfast, students must take at least 3 of the items and one must be $\frac{1}{2}$ cup of fruit or 1-100% juice cup or $\frac{1}{2}$ cup of vegetable. Students can refuse any item. If a student does not take enough items to make a meal, cashiers will ask the student if they would like to add more items. If the student refuses, we are required to charge the items on the tray as a la carte instead of the student meal rate of free, reduced, or paid.
