WHAT TO EXPECT

1. Parent or guardian completes an online survey to grant permission, if under the age of 18.


OR

If you are 18 or 19, you complete an online survey consenting to participate in the project.

2. 6-12th grade student completes online survey collecting preliminary information and you are contacted for scheduling.

3. Student participates in an in-person, CRATERS training at the UI College of Public Health and receives a \$20 Amazon e-gift card after completion.

4. Student completes 2 follow-up surveys, immediately after the workshop and 30 days later. Student receives \$5 Amazon e-gift card after completing the 2nd follow-up survey.

- Enrolled in grades 6-12 in Iowa City and surrounding areas
- Consent from Parent or Legal guardian
- Student assent (willingness)
- Transportation to and from site
