Transportation Parent App Announcement

EZ Arrival is an updated and integrated parent app launching this summer for EZRouting customers currently using EZ A2B. It provides proactive parent notifications, broad foreign language support, and an active development roadmap with multiple enhancements planned for release in 2026. **And best of all, existing parent accounts and settings in EZ A2B work automatically in EZ Arrival; no new registration, setup or training required!**

What this means for you:

- **Customers using EZ A2B:** EZ A2B will remain fully functional through the end of the 2025-2026 school year.

For the 2026–2027 school year, your district will transition to EZ Arrival. EZ Arrival has all the same features and functionality as EZ A2B coupled with performance improvements.

The switch is simple. All parents will need to do is download EZ Arrival and log in with their existing credentials. No new accounts, no re-registration.

Detailed migration guidance and parent communication templates will be provided in the coming weeks.

Free Summer Meals Available to All Children 18 Years and Under

The College Community School District is participating in the Summer Food Service Program. Meals will be provided to all children without charge and are the same for all children regardless of race, color, national origin, sex (including gender identity and sexual orientation), age or disability, and there will be no discrimination during the course of the meal service. Meals will be provided, at a first come, first serve basis, at the sites and times listed below:

All children aged 18 years and under qualify for free meals. Meals must be consumed on-site and food may not be taken from the site or shared with another person.

A breakfast meal includes a main entrée, fruit, juice, and milk.

A lunch meal includes a main entrée, fruit, vegetable, and milk.

SUN Bucks

The SUN Bucks program (also known as Summer EBT) provides families with **\$120 per child** in grocery benefits over the summer to help ensure children have access to nutritious food while school is out.

There are two ways children can qualify: automatic eligibility and application.

A child is automatically eligible if:

They were in grades K–12 during the 2025–2026 school year, and their school took part in the National School Lunch Program (NSLP), **OR** are 6-16 years old between July 1, 2025, and August 14, 2026.

All automatically eligible children must also meet at least one of the following:

- Their household received **SNAP** or **FIP**
- Their household received Medicaid at or below 185% of the federal poverty level
- They are in foster care
- They were approved for Free or Reduced-Price School Meals (through an application with their school or because they are homeless, a runaway, or a migrant)

If your child is not automatically eligible, you may complete an application once the application is available (early June), you can apply online by visiting our [webpage](https://hhs.iowa.gov/assistance-programs/food-assistance/sun-bucks).
