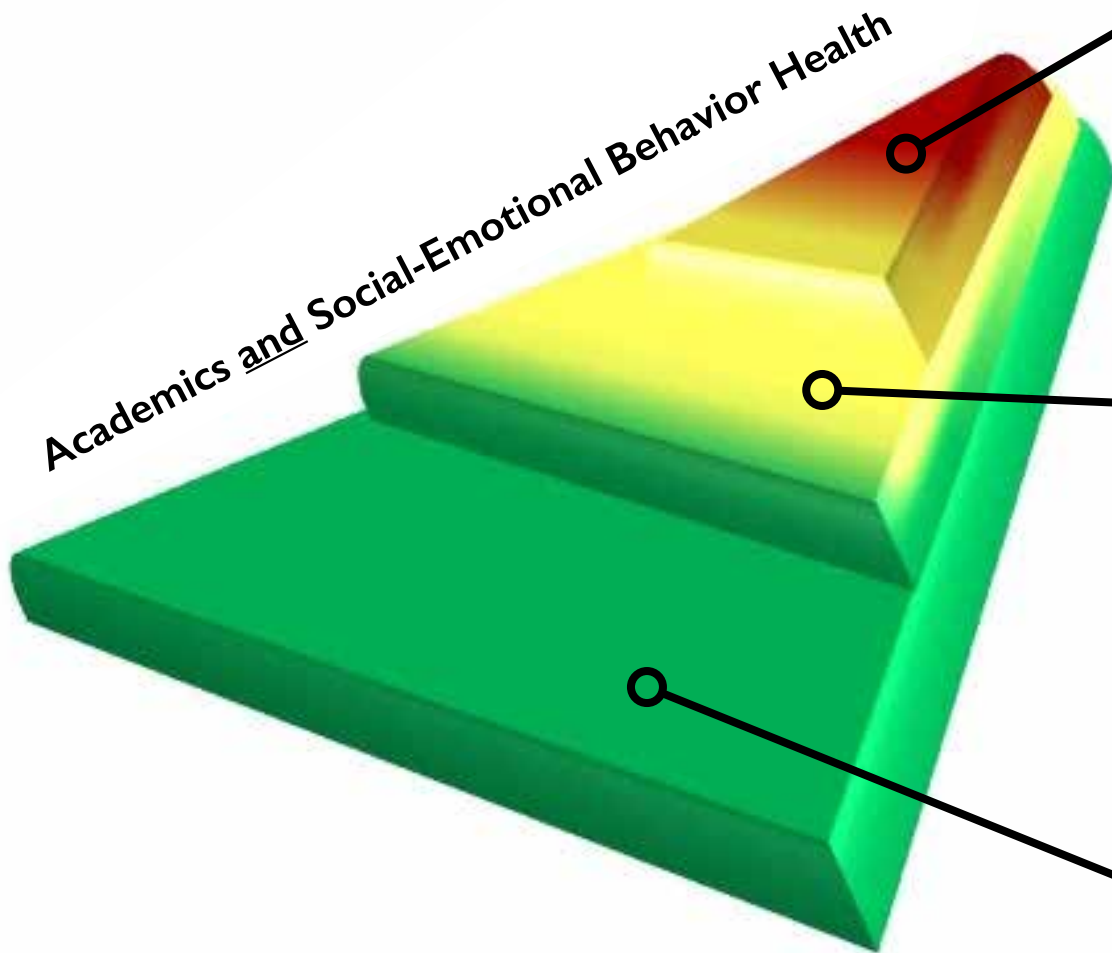


Elementary (4) College Community Gifted & Talented Multi-Tiered System of Supports (MTSS)



Tier III-Intensive

Acceleration: Whole grade or single subject level acceleration

Community Connections: Mentorship; Specialist partnerships

Counseling: Individual or small group counseling

Instruction: Independent studies

Tier II-Targeted

Structures: Cluster and/or flexible grouping; Curriculum compacting

Instruction: Above grade level instruction; Novel studies with an emphasis on critical and creative thinking; Future Problem Solving

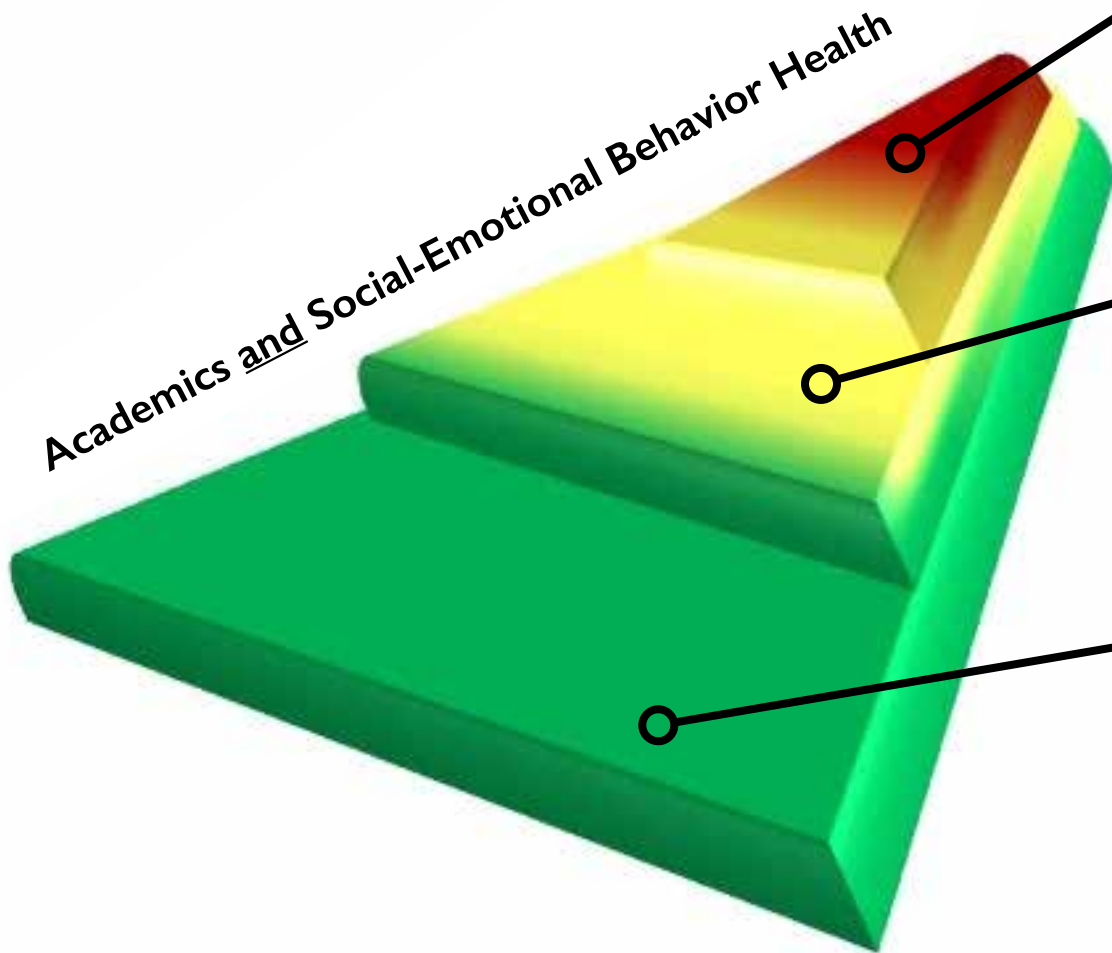
Extra Opportunities: Community partnerships

Tier I-Universal

Structures: Various groupings based on strength areas; Pre-assessment for differentiation

Instruction: Goal writing and reflections within Personal Education Plan; Project-based learning; Emphasis on personalized learning and social-emotional development

Tier III-Intensive

Acceleration: Whole grade or single subject acceleration

Extra Opportunities: Competitions

Tier II-Targeted

Structure: Flexible grouping based on strength areas, What I Need (WIN)

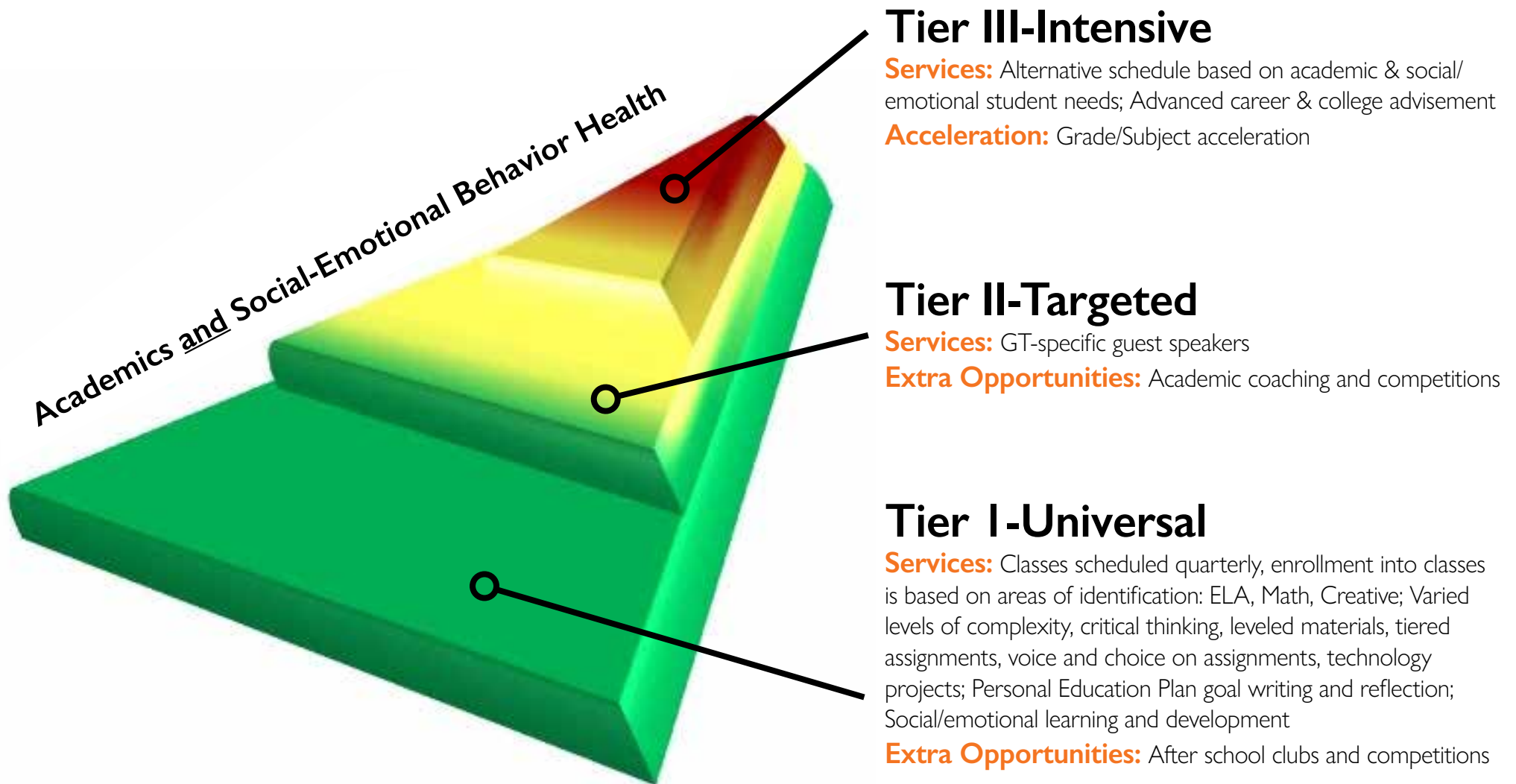

Tier I-Universal

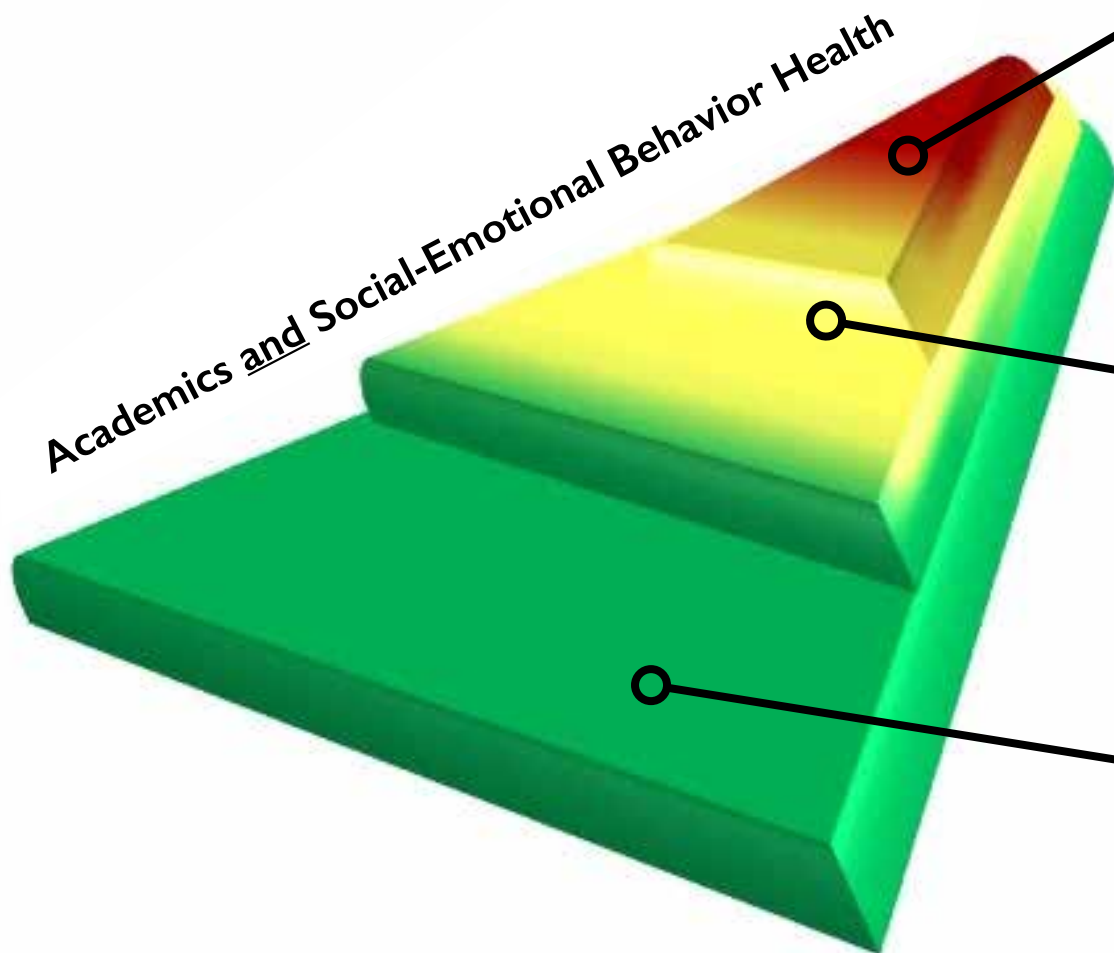
Structure: Various groupings based on strength areas; Cluster/flexible grouping

Instruction: Differentiated instruction; Creative and critical thinking activities; Personal Education Plan goal writing and reflection

Tier III-Intensive

Services: National Merit Advisement; Alternate schedule based on Academic or Social/Emotional Student Needs

Counseling: Individual and/or Small Group Mentoring

Acceleration: Grade Level Acceleration; Early Graduation/Early Entrance to College

Tier II-Targeted

Services: Dual Enrollment courses; College Visits; Single Subject Acceleration

Extra Opportunities: Competitions, Programs, and Teams; HS student mentors for elementary students

Tier I-Universal

Services: Using the Personal Education Plan to drive goal-setting, career and workplace connections; Individualized advisement and long-term planning; Advanced Placement courses; Pre-ACT/PSAT/ACT/SAT advisement; Assistance with college applications and essays
