Based upon guidance received from the Governor's Office of the State of Iowa, the Iowa Department of Education, the Iowa Department of Public Health, the Iowa Girls High School Athletic Union, and the Iowa High School Athletic Association and the Mississippi Valley Conference, the Prairie Activities Office has released its procedures for spectator admission for all 9-12 winter sports seasons.

Admission:

Normal admission will be charged at each venue. **Correct change preferred.** CCSD Activity Passes will be accepted for home events excluding tournaments and invitationals. *When spectator attendance is restricted spectator wristbands for the game will be given to the athlete. The wristband just guarantees the right to be admitted, a ticket must still be purchased or an activity pass shown to get into the game.*

Personal Protective Equipment:

- **Masks are required** at all MVC venues for all events at all times: Boys Basketball, Girls Basketball, Wrestling, Boys Bowling and Girls Bowling.
- Spectators are encouraged to bring their own hand sanitizer; spray sanitizer will be available.
- Temperature checks will be for all spectators for home and visitors

Attendance:

Attendance and capacity limited to 2 spectators per athlete, cheerleader, dance or staff participant where allowed per [Governor's Proclamation dated 12/09/2020](#). The venue will be cleared between games. Spectators are only allowed to attend the event their athlete is competing in.

- Basketball at Prairie HS and Prairie Point
 - **Masks are required** and social distancing according to venue signage
 - First 2 rows of bleachers will be blocked off. Handicap seating will be available
 - Prairie Activity Passes will be honored for non-tournament events.
- Wrestling at Prairie HS and Prairie Point
 - **Masks are required** and social distancing according to venue signage
 - First 2 rows of bleachers will be blocked off. Handicap seating will be available
 - Prairie Activity Passes will be honored for non-tournament events.
- Bowling at Lancer Lanes
 - No spectators will be allowed at matches for bowling due to limited space

Concessions:

Concessions will be offered based on guidelines set out by the Department of Education and the Department of Public Health.

Spectators are Asked to Accept Personal Responsibility for Following Public Health Guidelines:

- Practice safe social distancing (limit group to single households).
- Be patient and use common sense and abide by posted signage.
- Stay home if you show signs or symptoms or if you have been in contact with someone with a confirmed positive case of COVID-19 in the last 14 days or waiting for test results.
- Spectators not following guidelines will be asked to leave.
